

FORESTRY & HUNTING

HUNTING

Hunting immediately comes to mind when we think of timber and forests. The focal point on hunting covers this sector and showcases hunting weapons, binoculars, optical devices and hunting gear. Hunting clubs will also be present, and off-road vehicles will be on display.

FORESTRY

Continuing a long-standing tradition, forestry accounts for the most prominent and largest exhibition segment at this trade show. Presentations range from timber harvesting to cable crane technology, reforestation, clothing for forest workers, safety clothing and forestry tools. MOBILE SAWS AND BIOENERGY

Biomass is being increasingly used as an alternative to fossil fuels; it conserves natural resources and reduces harmful emissions. This section of the trade show is dedicated to various energy carriers, small-scale power stations,

screening and shredding systems plus combustion and environmental engineering systems. Mobile saws are a must, of course, at this trade show. What's special here is that visitors can see all machinery in operation live on site.



PARKING

Paid parking is available directly at the main entrance on St. Ruprechterstrasse or in the multi-storey car park (access from Messegelände Nord) for those who would like to park close to the exhibition grounds.

SHUTTLE SERVICE

For visitors arriving by car, free parking will be available at the car park at the Klagenfurt West motorway exit (August-Jaksch-Strasse slip road) and at the Minimundus P&R. Free shuttle buses will take visitors to and from the Exhibition Centre every 15 minutes. The shuttle buses run Wed-Fri, from 8:30 to 18:30, and Sat from 8:30 to 17:40. The last bus for the motorway car park leaves the exhibition grounds from the main entrance at 18:30 Wed-Fri and at 17:40 on Sat.
